Bunachar Logainmneacha na hÉireann  
Placenames Database of Ireland

Cuireann [www.logainm.ie](http://www.logainm.ie) na **leaganacha oifigiúla Gaeilge** de logainmneacha na hÉireann ar fáil don phobal. Tá fáil ar c.100,000 áit gheochódaithe agus c.200,000 logainm Gaeilge agus Béarla tríd an suíomh. Mínítear na míreanna logainmníochta Gaeilge is coitianta i ngluais ar an suíomh agus léirítear dáileadh na míreanna seo go grafach ar léarscáileanna. Tá c.23,000 taifeadadh fuaime ar fáil mar threoir d'fhuaimniú logainmneacha. Is féidir teacht ar shráidainmneacha ar an suíomh freisin.

Cuirtear **sonraí logainm.ie** ar fáil i bhformáidí atá inléite ag ríomhairí, agus cuimsíonn na sonraí seo naisc le Placenamesni.org, Wikipedia, Vicipéid, GeoNames, LinkedGeoData, DBpedia, agus WorldCat. Tá an bunchar á nascadh le tacar sonraí Teorainneacha Náisiúnta an OSi, agus tá naisc á gcruthú le hiontrálacha i mbunachair de chineálacha eile freisin, e.g. [www.ainm.ie](http://www.ainm.ie) agus [www.duchas.ie](http://www.duchas.ie).

Tá **ábhar breise logainmníochta** i bhfoirm nótaí eolais, tagairtí stairiúla, taifeadtaí fuaime stairiúla, léarscáileanna stairiúla, agus aistí ar fáil ar [logainm.ie](http://logainm.ie) freisin, chomh maith le hacmhainní oideachais logainmníochta i bhfoirm cluichí agus acmhainní teagaisc.

**Uirlis sluaifhoinisithe** is ea [meitheal.logainm.ie](http://meitheal.logainm.ie) chun mionainmneacha a chomhthiomsú. Leis an uirlis seo tugtar deis don phobal oidhreacht logainmníochta na tíre a chur chun cinn sa ré dhigiteach trí mhionainmneacha a mhapáil agus a roinnt ar líne. Ar an dóigh seo is féidir mionainmneacha a chaomhnú agus feasacht an phobail ina dtaobh a ardú.

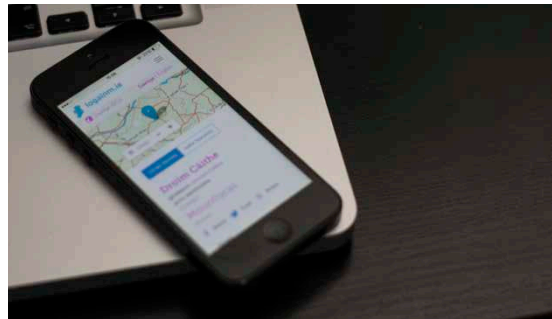
[www.logainm.ie](http://www.logainm.ie) provides the **official Irish-language forms** of the placenames of Ireland. c.100,000 geocoded places and c.200,000 Irish and English placenames can be accessed through the website. The most common Irish-language placename elements are explained in a glossary on the site, and the distribution of these elements is displayed graphically on maps. c.23,000 sound recordings are available as a guide to the pronunciation of placenames. Street names can also be found on the site.

**Logainm.ie** data is made available in machine-readable formats, as this data includes links to Placenamesni.org, Wikipedia, Vicipéid, GeoNames, LinkedGeoData, DBpedia, and WorldCat. The database is being connected to the OSi National Boundary dataset, and links are being created to entries in other types of databases as well, e.g. [www.ainm.ie](http://www.ainm.ie) and [www.duchas.ie](http://www.duchas.ie).

**Additional toponymic material** in the form of information notes, historical references, historical sound recordings, historical maps, and essays, are also available on [logainm.ie](http://logainm.ie), as well as toponymic educational resources in the form of games and teaching resources.

[meitheal.logainm.ie](http://meitheal.logainm.ie) is a **crowdsourcing tool** for pooling minor placenames. This tool provides users the opportunity to promote the toponymic heritage of the country in the digital age by mapping and sharing minor placenames online. This will enable the preservation of minor placenames as well as raising public awareness on the subject.
